ETCP Recognized Labor Providers will need to submit a renewal agreement prior to the expiration date to maintain recognition.

ETCP Recognized Labor Providers will:

- Be promoted on the ETCP website.
- May utilize the ETCP Recognized logo on the company's website and all printed materials.

These privileges are in effect for one year. Organizations who do not renew will be removed from the ETCP website and must remove the ETCP Recognized logo from their letterhead, website, and from all other advertising materials.
