Bring ETCP exams to your door

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BRINGING THE ETCP EXAMS to you? If you have as few as ten candidates interested in taking the test, ETCP can bring the test to you for a fee. We can schedule a proctor to come to your company or organization, and your technicians can take the exam all at once. There are a few key points that you should be aware of when applying to schedule a paper and pencil exam.

The first step to take when thinking about hosting on-site testing is to call the ETCP office and you will be sent more information to guide you in making decisions about what to offer your group. To qualify for an on-site administration, your group must have at least ten candidates, and it does not matter whether the candidates all take the same exam or are split between multiple exams.

All three exams are available for on-site testing, and may be offered concurrently or consecutively. You may choose to offer one, two, or all three exams. If candidates wish to take more than one exam, different times can be set up to accommodate them. ETCP's testing company, Applied Measurement Professionals (AMP) charges \$675 per test administration; so offering two of the exams would cost your group \$1,350; and offering all three would be \$2,025, plus application fees.

The ETCP On-Site Testing Agreement must be submitted a minimum of 12 weeks prior to the date of the requested examination. Submitting the request to ETCP as early as possible will help ensure that there are proctors available on your requested date. Although most requested dates can be accommodated, it is important to submit at least one alternate date.

All candidates wishing to take the examinations must fill out applications and submit them to ETCP at least six weeks before the scheduled examination. It must be noted on the application that the candidate wishes to take the exam at your on-site location. ETCP uses a points system to determine eligibility to sit for all examinations. Points are awarded for various work experience, training (i.e. internships and apprenticeships), and education. Rigging and Electrical applications and handbooks are available online at http://etcp.esta.org. If you would like multiple handbooks mailed to you, please contact certification@esta.org or call 212.244.1505. Your organization may provide a location for testing, but the site must meet the specifications set forth by AMP. If you do not have a room or hall that is large enough to accommodate your group, a testing site can be provided by AMP, but additional fees will apply. All examinations require a standardized testing environment. The proctors from AMP will provide the testtakers with all supporting materials such as formula sheets, exam booklets, and scratch paper. ETCP will send calculators and architect scale rules.

Once your on-site testing date has been secured and the candidates are accepted, ETCP will send out notices with the location and time of your on-site administration. When reporting to the site, the candidates must be on time and will be asked to show two forms of identification, and one of these must be a picture ID.

ETCP must receive digital images of the certificants to print ID Cards after a candidate passes the exam. Photos may be submitted by email by the certificants after the exam, a representative from your organization may take photos the day of the exam, or ETCP can assist in hiring a portrait photographer in the area for an additional fee.

ETCP and AMP will send out notices to the candidates with examination results within six weeks of the exam date. Passing candidates will receive an ID card, certificate, patch, pin, and sticker, and will be added to the list of certified technicians on the ETCP website.
