Congratulations on your certification and thank you for your commitment and dedication to safety in our industry.



## ETCP Electrical Examination Update

Over 800 entertainment electricians agreed to participate in the ETCP electrical job analysis survey distributed in December 2005. The results of this survey, analyzed by the ETCP Subject Matter Experts and psychometrician early this year, will be used to determine the content areas of the examination. The next step in the test development process will be to write the examination questions, which will take place over a series of meetings to be held through the first half of 2006.

The first electrical examination will be held at the 2006 LDI trade show in Las Vegas, NV. Candidate handbooks and applications for the electrical examination will be available in March.
